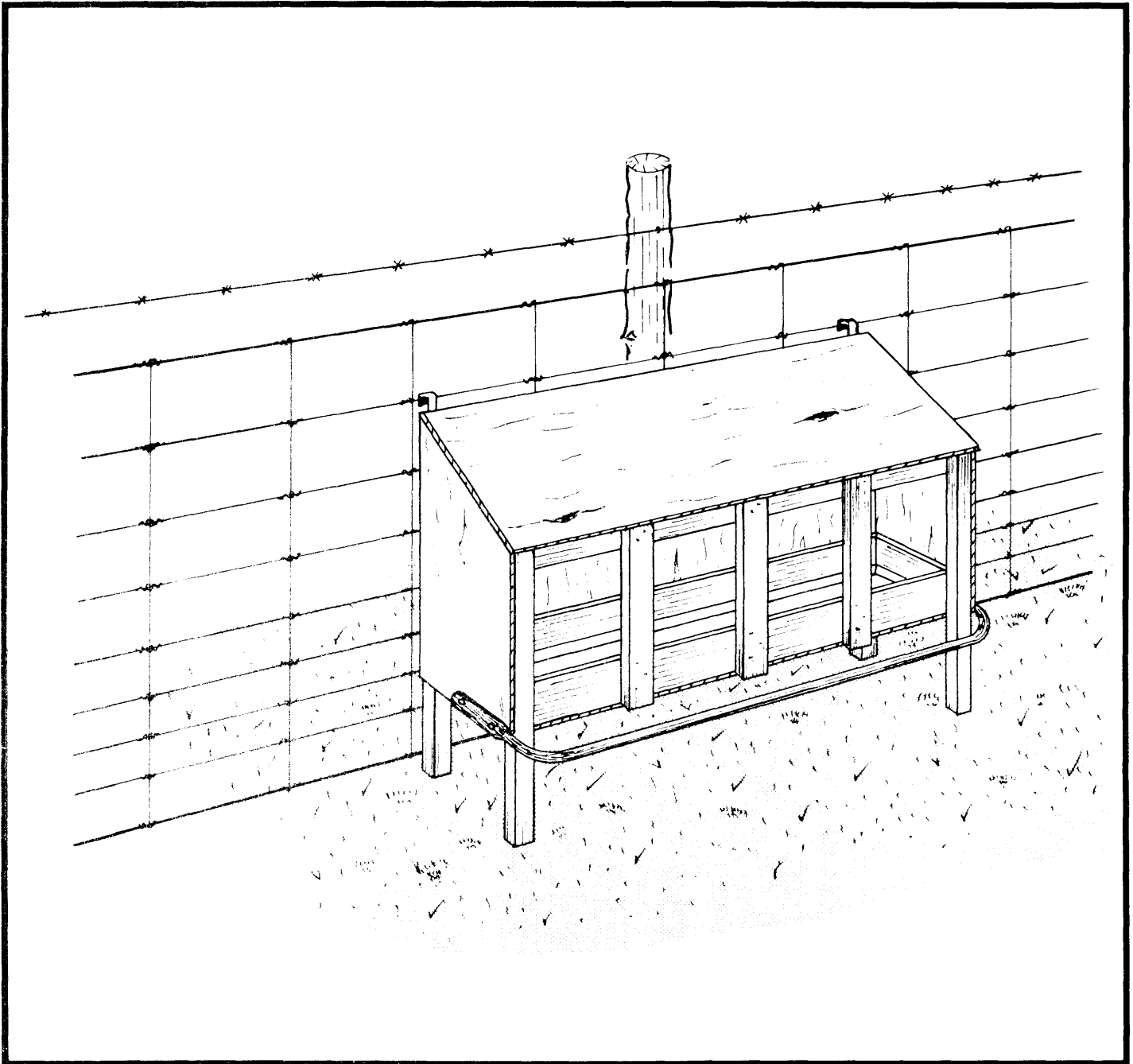


FIXED MINERAL BOX

FIXED MINERAL BOX

PLAN 4613 REVISED 80:6

The mineral box is a practical method of providing minerals to sheep in field or feedlot.

This box is framed and sheathed on the back, sides and bottom with plywood. A front board prevents wastage. Vertical spacers provide individual feed openings. Flat iron hangers are fastened to the back of the box for hanging on a fence or a building, and a steel pipe guard rail around the front keeps the sheep from soiling the inside of the box.

1. 3/8" plywood
2. 2" x 2" framing
3. 1" x 4" front board
4. 450 cant strip, out of 2" x 2"
5. 2" x 2" leg
6. 1" x 3" dividers
7. 3/4" diam. pipe, ends flattened and drilled for 5/16" bolts
8. hooks, out of flat iron
